



Getting Started with the Just Mobile® RoKy2 Windows XP Installation

These instructions were created using a Sony Vaio VGN-UX17GP (XP)

- 1) Download the attached Windows XP drivers to your PC.
- 2) 'Save' to download the zipped files ('.zip') to a location on the hard disk of the Windows XP device you want to use the keyboard with
- 3) When download is complete, locate the zipped folder on your computer. To extract the files, double-click the zipped file to open Winzip, and then click 'Extract'. Specify where you want to store the extracted files by choosing the folder in the "Extract" window
- 4) Run the set-up file - PCBTFKsetup.ms1 and follow the prompts
- 5) The application will now be found on the 'Start' menu or your PC
- 6) Open Bluetooth Control panel either through start menu or by double clicking Bluetooth control on task bar before beginning.
 - a) Choose "New Connection" from panel
 - b) Choose "Custom Mode" then turn keyboard on and click "Next"
 - c) Keyboard should be shown in the list of available Bluetooth devices, highlight and click "Next"
 - d) Choose Serial Port on list and click "Next"
 - e) Uncheck "Use default COM port"
 - f) Use pull down bar to choose an acceptable port (Port 6 appears to have no conflicts) and keep "Auto Connect" checked
 - g) Choose a name for the device ("keyboard" is the default name) and change icon if you wish
 - h) Complete connection and click "Finish"
 - i) Your device will now be shown in Bluetooth Settings panel
 - j) Open up the BT Fabric keyboard panel software from Start Menu and change the com port on the Bluetooth Settings tab, then click "Apply" and then click connect

- k) Fabric Keyboard will beep to state it is connected and also display Battery status at the bottom.

User Hint : My Keyboard won't stay On : Power On Procedure :

- I. Press & hold the Power Button until the Green Light comes on
- II. When the Green Light will come on, release the Power Button
- III. The Green Light will go out, but will come back on & blink a few times
- IV. After a couple of blinks, the Green Light will stay on

Note : You must pair the keyboard with your PC before trying to connect through the application. Make sure you note down the Bluetooth com port number allocated to the keyboard, this is used by the application to connect to the keyboard.
